## Reading Indyreads eBooks on your eReader


Patrons can borrow eBooks from Inner West eLibrary and read them on their eReader.

Before you start, make sure you have:

- A valid library card
- Internet access
- [Adobe Digital Editions Account](#)

## Borrowing Indyreads eBooks from the library catalogue

1. Log into the catalogue with your membership number and password/PIN and identify an eBook (belonging to Indyreads platform) that you are interested in borrowing.
2. Click on View availability.



## Notes:

Usually, an eBook can be borrowed by one person at a time. If a book is on loan, you'll see an option to place a hold on the book. When the book becomes available, you'll receive a notification email.

3. Click on Borrow this eBook.



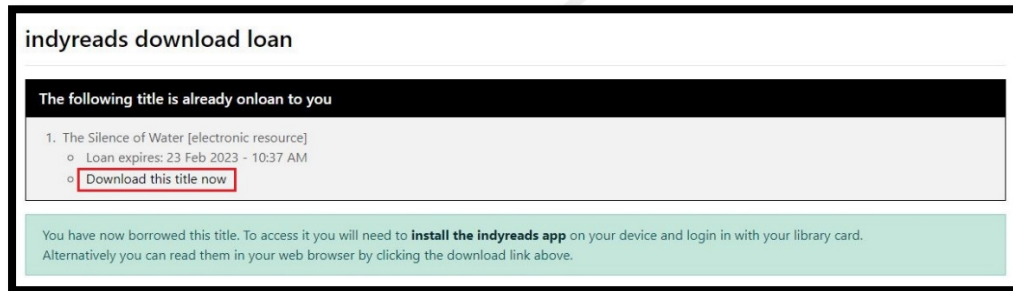
4. Select **ebook (DRM)** format and then click on **Continue**.

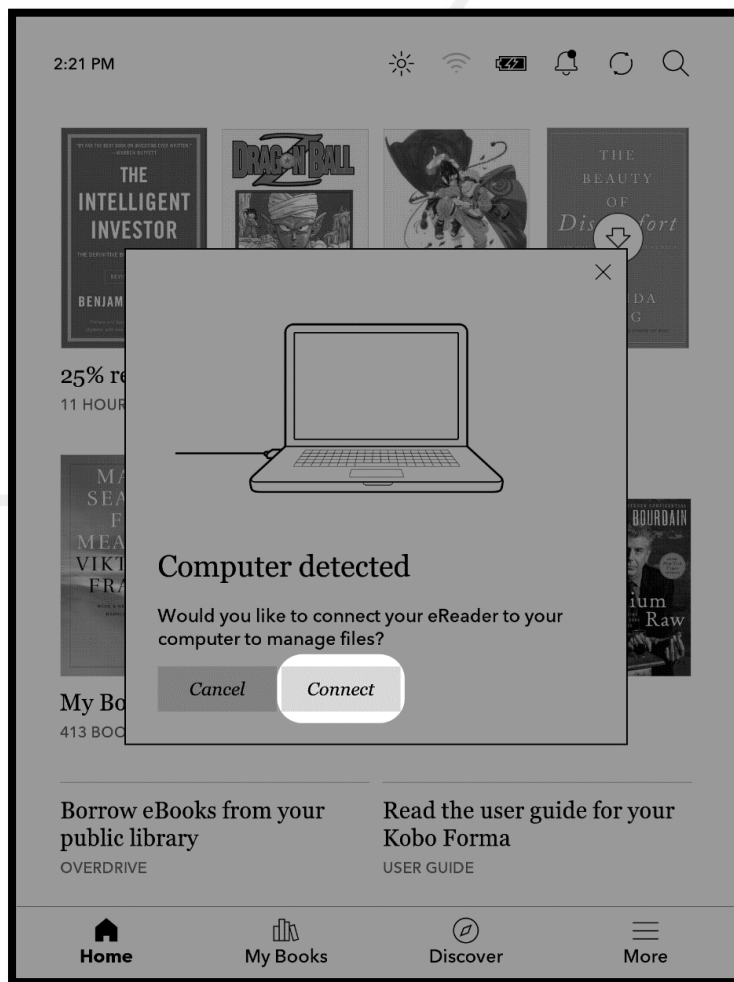

## Transferring the eBook to an eReader device


1. Connect your eReader to your computer using a Micro USB cable.
2. Tap **Connect** on your eReader.



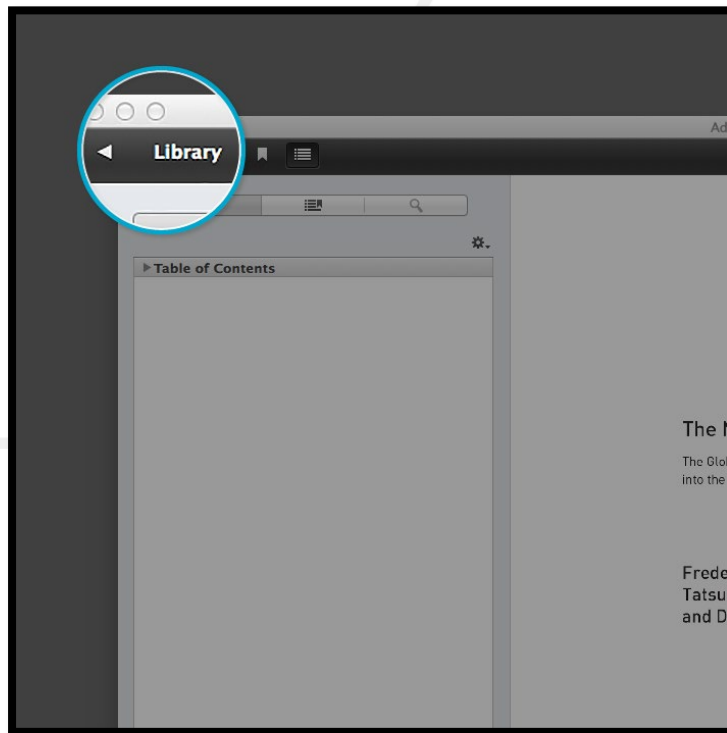

3. On your computer:

a. Go to the folder where your eBook (the .acsm file) is saved.

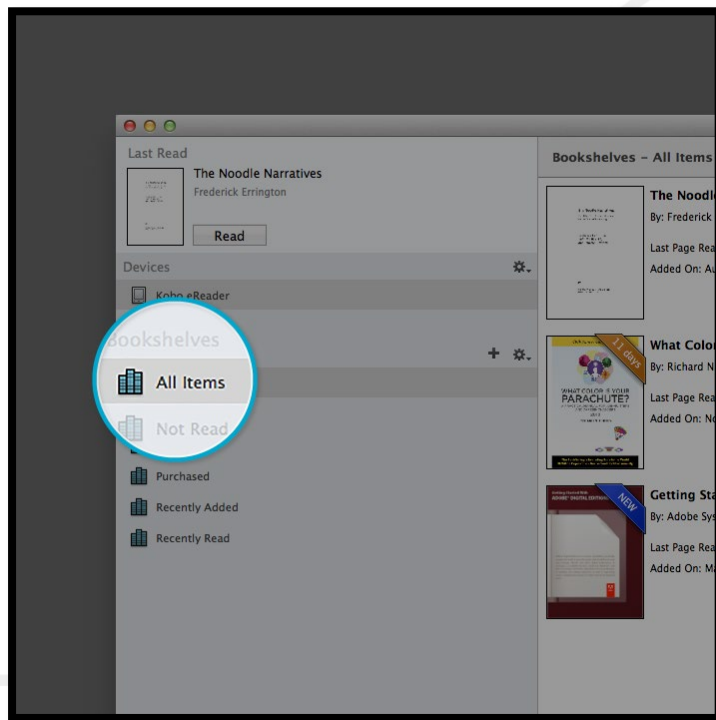
b. Double-click the .acsm file. The book will open in ADE.

c. Click **Library** at the top of the screen.

d. Click All Items under the Bookshelves menu.



e. Click on your new book and drag it to your eReader listed on the left side under Devices.

4. Eject your eReader from the computer and unplug the USB cable. Your eReader will show Processing Content message. The library book will appear on your eReader's Home Screen.

## Borrowing an eBook from the Indyreads website

1. Sign into the [Indyreads website](#) with your membership number and password/PIN and identify an eBook that you are interested to borrow.

### Notes:

Select **Inner West Council** as the library name.

2. Click on **Borrow**.

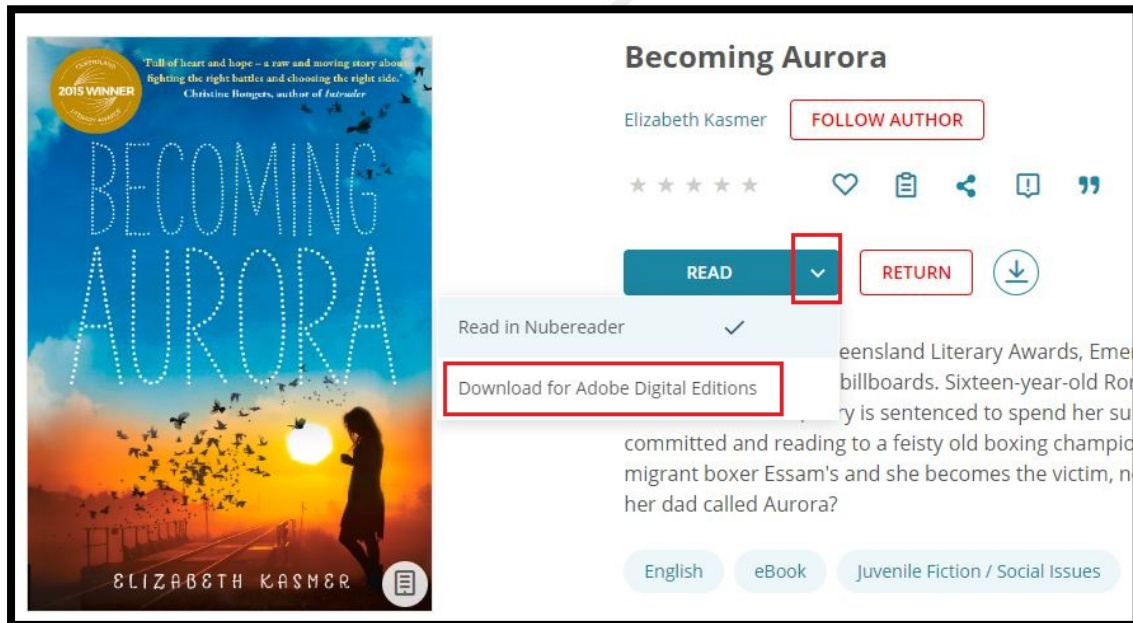

3. Click on **Download for Adobe Digital Editions** to download the .acsm file onto your computer.
