Reading Libby eBooks on your eReader


Patrons can borrow eBooks from Inner West eLibrary and read them on their eReader.

- [Adobe Digital Editions Account](#)


Borrowing Libby eBooks from the library catalogue

1. Log into the catalogue with your membership number and password/PIN and identify a Libby eBook that you are interested in borrowing.
2. Click on View availability.





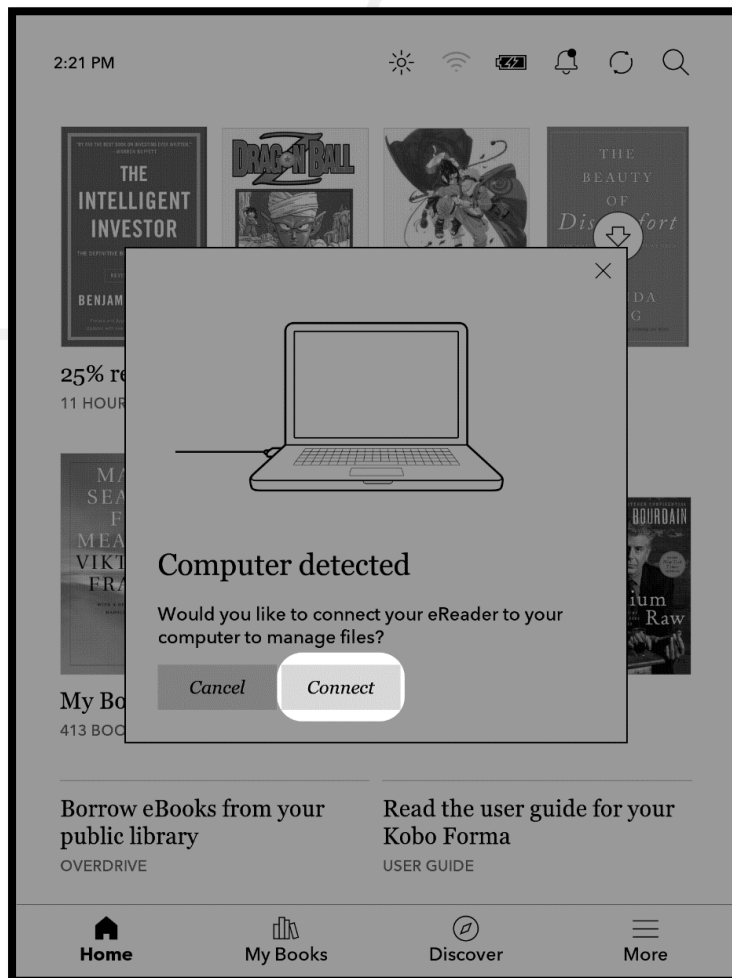

Transferring the eBook to an eReader device


1. Connect your eReader to your computer using a Micro USB cable.
2. Tap **Connect** on your eReader.



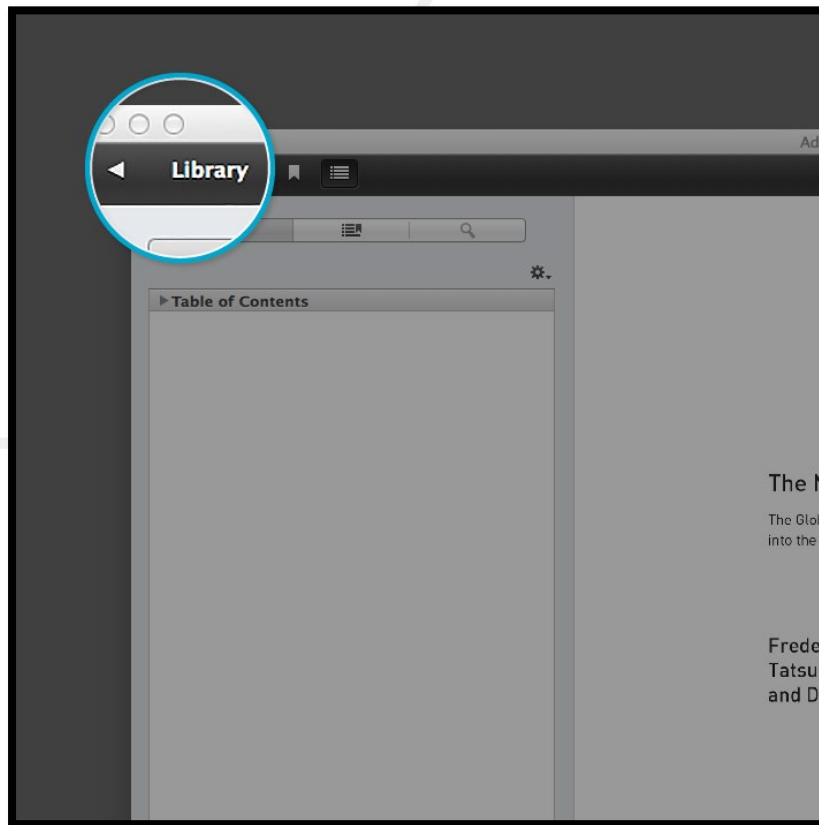

3. On your computer:

a. Go to the folder where your eBook (the .acsm file) is saved.

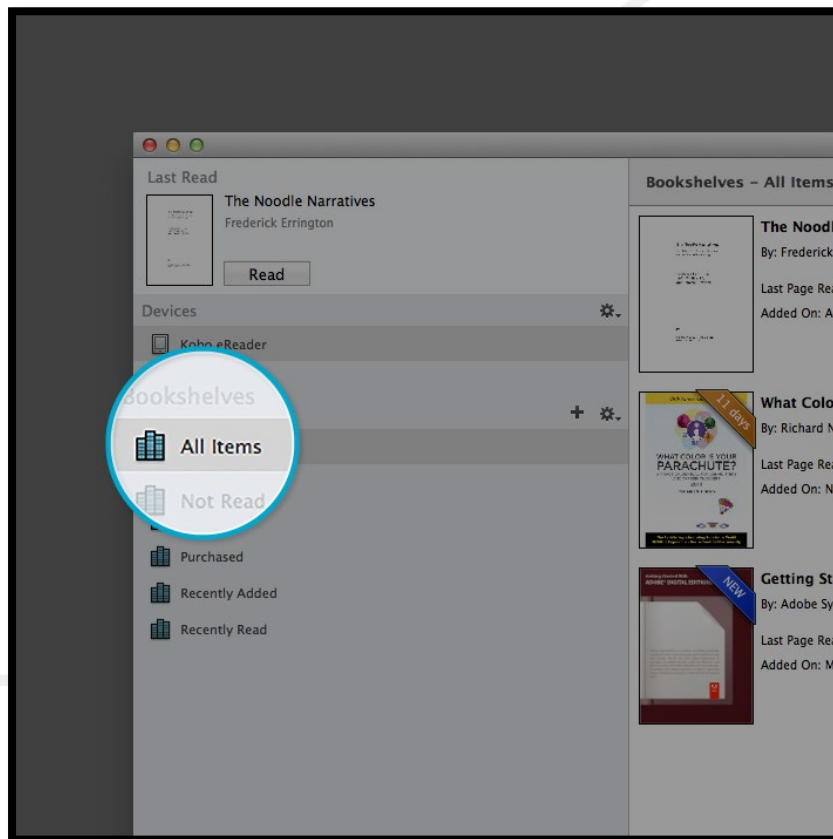
b. Double-click the .acsm file. The book will open in ADE.

c. Click **Library** at the top of the screen.

d. Click All Items under the Bookshelves menu.



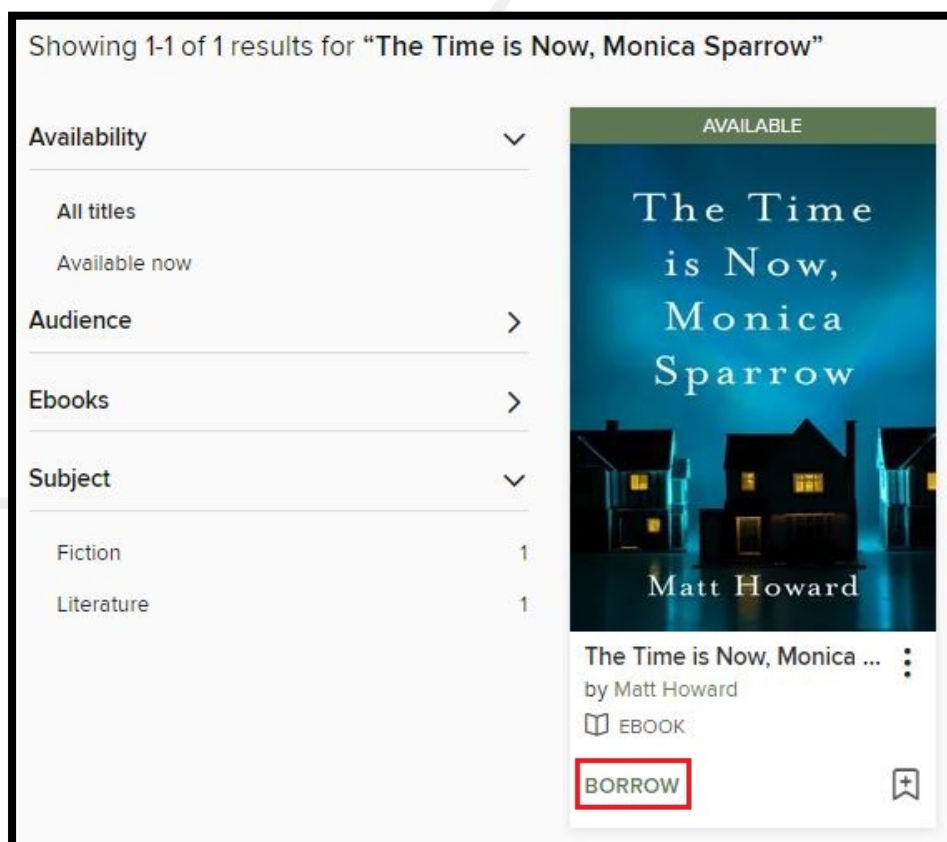
e. Click on your new book and drag it to your eReader listed on the left side under Devices.

4. Eject your eReader from the computer and unplug the USB cable. Your eReader will show Processing Content message. The library book will appear on your eReader's Home Screen.

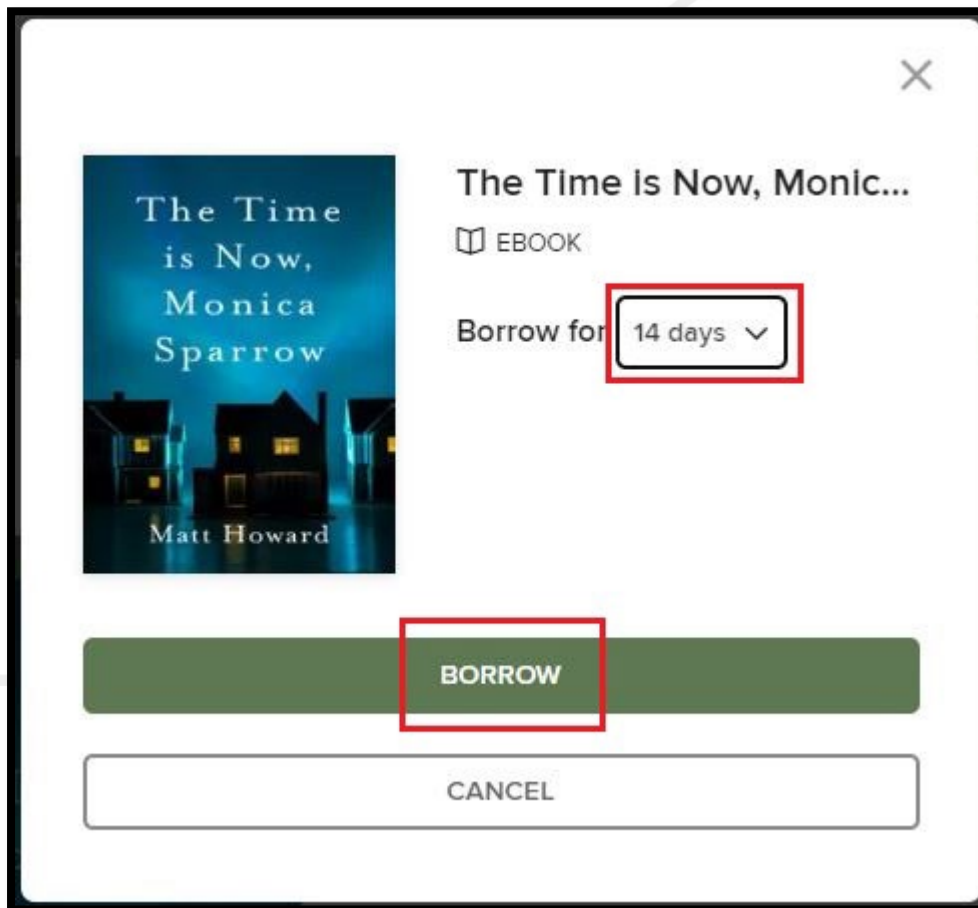
Borrowing an eBook from the Libby website

2. Click on **Borrow**.





3. Choose the loan period and click again on **Borrow**.




