- Level 1 carpark can be accessed via Knox Street.
- The Rooftop carpark can be best accessed via the Norton Street entrance.
   There are 4 mobility parking spaces adjacent to the rooftop elevator.

#### Taxi and Rideshare:

- There is a taxi rank at the Ashfield Train Station.
- Passenger drop off may also occur on the rooftop carpark at Ashfield Mall near the elevator for best access.

Accessibility note: If arriving at the rooftop level, take the lift to level 3 of the mall. Turn left and head towards the front entry. Once outside the main entry there is a pathway and automated glass door to your right that leads to the Ashfield Civic Centre. The Town Hall can be entered off the lower level of this foyer.
