

# **GreenWay Night Works**

## **Longport Street, Lewisham**

### **DATES CHANGED TO: 3 May 7pm – 4 May 5am**

The GreenWay is a major pedestrian, cycling and biodiversity corridor linking the Cooks River at Earlwood with the Parramatta River at Iron Cove. As the next phase of the GreenWay construction, investigations into a watermain on Longport Street bridge are taking place.

#### **Where will the work be undertaken?**

Construction night work will be undertaken on the footpath on the northern side of Longport Street bridge. The footpath in this location will be closed and a detour will be in place for pedestrians. Roads will not be affected during the works.

#### **What type of work is being done?**

Investigations into a watermain on Longport Street bridge will be undertaken by excavation by a small excavator. Once investigations are complete, the excavated area will be filled in again and the footpath can re-open.

These excavations are necessary to enable adjustments to the watermain at a later stage.

#### **When will the work be undertaken?**

The night work will take place from Friday 3 May 7pm to Saturday 4 May 5am. These works can only take place during these hours due to the limited path closure hours during the day and also to reduce the impact to pedestrians.

Once the investigation work is complete, additional night work is expected to take place in May. Residents will be advised of this in a separate notice.

#### **What will be done to minimise inconvenience for me?**

Every effort will be made to minimise noise associated with the works. The excavator is the minimum size required for this excavation work and traffic control will be implemented.
