

GreenWay construction and diversion routes confirmed

The GreenWay is a major active travel and biodiversity corridor linking the Cooks River at Earlwood with the Parramatta River at Iron Cove. Approvals have been received to start the latest stage of construction from 28 August 2023, with the GreenWay expected to be completed in 2025.

Where will the work be undertaken?

The work will be undertaken mostly inside the light rail corridor, near the areas below:

- Constitution Road area to Dulwich Grove light rail station, from 28 August 2023
- Lewisham West light rail area, from 4 September 2023
- Cadigal Reserve, from October 2023 (TBC)
- Davis Street area, from January 2024
- Hercules Street Parkland, from January 2024
- Johnson Park upgrades, from July 2024

Vehicle diversion route – Constitution Road bridge

Some temporary road closures are unavoidable. To minimise impact on residents and other road users, detours and traffic management plans will be in place.

The road closure of Constitution Road bridge has been planned in the week of Monday 11 September 2023 to January 2024. A detour will be in place for all traffic via Windsor Road, Davis Street bridge, Grove Street and Denison Road.

Pedestrian and cyclist diversion routes

Residents and businesses are advised of the timeframe of closures and alternative pedestrian and cyclist diversion routes for Cadigal Reserve for 12 months, from October 2023. The pedestrian bridge closure over Hawthorne Canal near Lords Rd is postponed to early 2024.

Fencing Installation Night Works 4-6 September

To enable construction of the GreenWay, temporary construction site fencing will be installed to ensure a safe construction site.

Where will the work be undertaken?

Construction night work will be undertaken inside the light rail corridor near Lewisham West light rail station between Longport Street and Old Canterbury Road.

What type of work is being done?

Temporary construction site fencing will be installed, separating the light rail from the GreenWay construction area.

When will the work be undertaken?

The night work will take place from Monday 4 September to Wednesday 6 September, from about 11pm to 6am. The temporary fencing can only be safely placed at night, when there is no light rail train movement.

What will be done to minimise inconvenience for me?

Every effort will be made to minimise noise. The delivery of fence panels will take place during the day. At night, the fencing will be installed by hand, with minimal use of low noise power tools.
