

## GENERAL NOTE

• Prior to the commencement of work, Tree Protection Zones shall be established in accordance with AS4970-2009 (Protection of Trees on Development Sites) with protective fences at least 1.8 metres high erected outside the drip lines from the trunks of the trees which are required to be retained. The protective fences shall consist of chain wire mesh temporary fence panels securely mounted and braced to prevent movement, shall be in place prior to the commencement of any work on site and shall remain until the completion of all building and hard landscape construction. Excavations of Services, waste bins, storage of materials and equipment, site residue, site sheds, vehicle access or cleaning of tools and equipment are not permitted within the Tree Protection Zone at any Time

## cleaning of tools and equipment are not permitted within the Tree Protection Zone at any Time. $\bigcirc$ · Prior to the commencement of any work on site, sings shall be placed in prominent positions on each protective fence identifying the area as a Tree Protection Zone and prohibiting the above mentioned items within the fenced off areas. · If roots are exposed during any demolition and construction phase, or where root pruning may be required a Consultant Arborist with AQF Level 5 qualifications in Horticulture (Arboriculture) must be present to supervise the building works and certify compliance with all Tree Protection Measures. $\bigcirc$ Steel Park











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
