CLIMATE JUSTICE WORKSHOPS

Climate change is affecting everyone across our planet, however its impacts are not felt equally. It is especially young people, First nations people and those communities that are already marginalised that are the most affected.

Our in-school climate justice workshop uses a peer to peer approach to engage students with climate science, and the impacts climate change is already having around the world. It explores the idea of climate justice - that those who are most impacted have done the least to contribute to the problem, and the exciting opportunities for young people to take action to contribute to a fairer, cleaner and more sustainable future.

The workshop will cover the Australian Curriculum's Cross Curriculum priority of Sustainability (OI: 3, 4, 6, 7, 8, 9). It can also fit in with learning areas including the Humanities, English and Science.

Highly trained AYCC facilitators deliver 40-80 minute interactive workshops in-school on climate justice and solutions

Best suited to students in year 9 or above. Workshops can be delivered to a class, year level or as part of an assembly
