BLACKMORE OVAL, LEICHHARDT – EASTERN PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE REPLACEMENT

Inner West Council will soon be investing \$75,000 to replace the Blackmore Oval Eastern Pedestrian Bridge.

The project involves:

- Demolition of the existing bridge and balustrade.
- Construction of a new suspended slab footbridge and balustrade.
- footbridge.

Timing of work

The works will commence on Thursday 13 June 2024 and take approximately two weeks to complete (weather permitting).

Reducing construction impacts

Traffic Control will be used to maintain traffic and pedestrian flow around the site.

Access to Blackmore Oval and the shared pedestrian cycle path from Charles St will be available via the existing pedestrian footbridge located approximately 50m downstream of the bridge.
