Upcoming Traffic Works – Intersection of Wardell Road and Bedford Crescent, Dulwich Hill

Dear Residents,

Inner West Council will soon invest \$72,000 to upgrade traffic facilities at the intersection of Wardell Road and Bedford Crescent, Dulwich Hill. This upgrade aims to enhance pedestrian amenity and safety, as well as promote reduced vehicle speeds. The works will include installing a new landscaped kerb blister island adjacent to the existing raised pedestrian crossing, and partially removing the current threshold ramps while installing new concrete kerb blisters. The works will commence the week of 22 July 2024 and take approximately two weeks to complete (weather permitting).

Please avoid parking next to or near the active work zones.
