GreenWay construction notice

**Footpath closure on Hercules Street, Dulwich Hill
Monday 14 April to Thursday 24 April 2025**

The GreenWay is a major pedestrian, cycling, and biodiversity corridor linking the Cooks River at Earlwood with the Parramatta River at Iron Cove. As part of the GreenWay construction, footpath works will need to take on Hercules Street in Dulwich Hill.

Where will the construction take place?

Construction will take place on the footpath adjacent to 43 Hercules Street in Dulwich Hill. This area of footpath will be closed throughout these works and a pedestrian detour will be in place.

The three parking spaces located in front of 43 Hercules Street will be unavailable during the work period.

What type of work is being done?

A section of the driveway and layback will be demolished and replaced with a kerb, gutter and plantings.

When will these works take place?

To help minimise disruption these works will take place during the April school holidays from Monday 14 to Thursday 24 April 2025 (weather permitting).

Works hours: 7am – 5pm, Monday to Friday.

What will be done to minimise inconvenience for me?

A detour will be in place to divert pedestrians at the pedestrian crossings located on either side of the works.

Access to Dulwich Hill Public School will be maintained.

The contractor will undertake mitigation measures in accordance with their Construction Environmental Management Plan to reduce noise, dust, and debris associated with these works.
