What can the GCF do? Contact IWC to inform them to consult with Forum on anything on the GW.</li> <li>AL: this is an in-principal agreement and issues raised by BA will be open for discussion before implementation.</li> <li>BA: one or two storage shipping containers: visual impacts if by the water, but safer for traffic if not crossing the road. We need more information and details.</li> <li>NC: how long is this agreement for? NC: in principle this is a suitable activity for GW</li> </ul>
