

- Secured funding for 136 charging ports
- All chargers to be installed by end of April 2025 and open to the public 24 hours a day






Types of chargers


- 99 x 22kW chargers (134 charging ports)
- 1 x 60kW charger (2 charging ports)
- 93 dedicated charging bays and 41 non-dedicated bays
- All chargers are BYO cables except for 60kW charger that has CCS2 charger







Community engagement findings

7th November – 13 December 2023

- 1053 people visited Your Say page.
- 58 completed the online survey.
- 20 people attended the on-site pop-up held on 28 November
- 70% of online respondent support.

Key suggestions:


- Incorporate Chinese culture and promote diversity.
- Include opportunities for local market, and outdoor café extension.
- Provide shade, natural or man-made.

Further investigations underway:


- Replace Ashfield Council sign with new illuminated

That Council notes that investigations and feasibility studies undertaken by Council show that the 6-storey rezonings proposed under the Government's Transport Orientated Development scheme will not lead to the required number of new homes actually being delivered.

That Council notes that the feasibility studies undertaken demonstrate that small lot sizes and high land values in the Inner West mean that higher densities will be required to make amalgamation and development of these sites commercially viable.

That Council commits to finalising and bringing a draft LGA-wide LEP no later than the April 2025 Council meeting.

That Council commits to a public exhibition in April 2025.
